**Approval of Minutes** - Melissa requested a change in the meeting minutes as presented from the September 29, 2025 meeting. Jaime will change the minutes and resubmit.

**Treasurer's Report** - Bank balance is \$2,104.44. Funding was received from the division in an amount of \$1,314.42. There is an outstanding invoice to pay from Halloween treats. Kristie will submit her receipt for Halloween treats.

**School Report** - See attached. 81 students currently, no staff changes. M. Lecuyer is teaching grade 8/9 Motors in PAA. D. Fehr is back in January. Education week is complete. The SRC is busy. Thoughtful snacks will be purchased for the SCC to sell at functions that everyone can enjoy after they purchase. Basketball is beginning shortly, volleyball is all wrapped up. Gym equipment has been gone through and reordered. There has been interest in the yearbook so a student/teacher committee has been formed. Christmas Concert discussion will happen tomorrow with staff. A school survey will be sent out next week for students to take part in. Edsby will be used as a communication tool for students/parents and Facebook will be used as a communication tool for the community. Fundraisers will no longer be a Fall decision, the fundraisers for next school year will be decided and voted on in the Spring.

**Open Issues** - A question was asked if the kids bags/backpacks could be set inside when kids are dropped off in the morning. Can kids also warm up and use the washroom? Melissa to check what other schools are doing. It's a supervision issue and not enough supervision for kids to be inside and outside. There was also a concern about kids hanging out around where the buses are stopping. It was explained that the kids disburse after they are dropped off so there is no concern because supervision is right there. Two supervisors are now on supervision outside at all times.

## School Report

Enrollment is up to 81 students, with no staffing changes. Space adjustments are underway to support new programming, including small motors in PAA. Education Week featured themed activities, and SRC has planned spirit days, a Halloween carnival, and a Remembrance Day service.

Sports updates: cross-country has wrapped, volleyball playoffs are underway, and basketball will begin soon. Gym equipment has been reorganized to support safe use and student responsibility.

Teachers are engaging in professional development through Innovation Sprints focused on observation-based assessment. Career education for Grades 7–9 is being implemented via MyBlueprint. Edsby is now connected to all families, and the OurSchool Survey is scheduled for next week.

Upcoming non-school days: Nov. 3 (White Fox Day), Nov. 10 (SIP), and Nov. 11 (Remembrance Day). SCC AGM planning is underway, with fundraising decisions deferred to spring.
