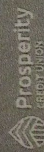

White Fox School Strategic Plan 2025–2026

1. Student Engagement & Family Partnerships

Career Education (Grades 7–9)

- All students in Grades 7–9 will have an updated MyBlueprint account, serving as a portfolio that will follow them through Grade 12

Family Understanding of Self-Regulation

- Families will receive the **Self-Regulation Handbook** and common strategies and tips for Self-Regulation
- Goal: Families and students will use shared self-reg language by June 2026

2. High-Quality Teaching, Assessment & Learning

Improving Math Instruction (K–8)

- Teachers will use a variety of math tools to get students thinking and engaging with math

Strengthening Assessment Practices

- Teachers will gather evidence of learning through conversations, observations, and products—not just tests
- Students will better understand **how they are doing** and **their next steps**

Digital Documentation & Student Agency

- Students will upload learning evidence and reflections throughout the year
- Target: Each student will have **two reflective Learning Story posts** by June 2026

3. School Culture, Well-being & Equity

Self-Regulation in Classrooms

- All classrooms will include self-reg materials and routines
- Goal: Students will identify stressors and regulate more quickly and independently

Equity & Belonging

- Year 1 focus: **Belonging** and reframing deficit thinking
- Staff will work to identify and address barriers for marginalized students

Staff Well-Being

- Guarding Minds wellness data will guide our school's ongoing staff wellness goals (not received yet)

4. Effective Processes & Professional Growth

Response to Intervention (Rti)

- Six-week Rti cycles will guide early, responsive support for students.
- Goal: actionable steps for staff and students to support needs

Innovation Sprints

- Teacher's growth plan; improving teaching practices to impact student learning
